Join your webinar host **CAADS Executive Director Lydia Missaelides and Senator Roy Afflerbach, Ret., our Public Policy Advisor for the National Adult Day Services Association (NADSA)** to hear the latest political news from Washington DC. With Congress on summer recess and only a few months remaining in the first half of the legislative session what are chances that a deal to repeal, replace or amend the Affordable Care Act could happen? What are the political forces behind the historic drive to cut Medicaid funding by 33% over the next decade? Can these forces be stopped? **After completing the webinar you will be able to:**
