The fast spread and emerging risk factors for vulnerable older and immunocompromised adults created by the Delta variant have necessitated urgent new state and local Public Health Orders requiring masking, vaccination, and testing for staff in Adult Day Health Care and Adult Day Programs. It is critically important to understand these new requirements and why they are needed.
