CBAS is a licensed health facility servicing adults 18+ with chronic qualifying health or cognitive conditions in a safe and caring day center setting, to support their ability to live in their community and out of institutional care.

We are a person-centered interdisciplinary team of nurses, social workers, dietitians, therapists and aides integrating health and human services inside and outside of our center. Medi-Cal managed care plans pay for CBAS.

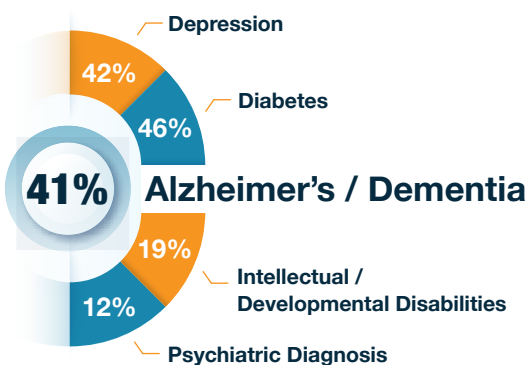
