Call for Nominations!

The Board Development Committee invites you to submit a nomination for a position on the California Association for Adult Day Services (CAADS) Board and/or the Board of the Alliance for Leadership and Education (A.L.E.).

California Association for Adult Day Services (CAADS) is a 501 (c) (6) mutual benefit corporation serving the needs of its members. Fifteen members of the Board of Directors are elected by the membership. Three members serve at the pleasure of the President. There are three (3) positions open for election to three-year terms beginning JANUARY 1, 2026, and ending DECEMBER 31, 2028. A list of current CAADS Board members and terms of office is enclosed.

The Alliance for Leadership and Education (ALE) is a 501 (c) (3) public benefit corporation whose members are comprised of CAADS members. The ALE manages grant activities and public information activities. The seven (7) member Board of Directors is *elected* by its membership (CAADS/Alliance members) and selected by the CAADS Board of Directors. One (1) position is open for election to a three-year term beginning JANUARY 1, 2026, and ending DECEMBER 31, 2028.

To Serve on the CAADS Board of Directors

Serving on the CAADS Board is an excellent opportunity to be closely involved in shaping the future of adult day services and to participate in the critical issues facing our industry. Your program and leadership team will benefit from your enriched experience, as well. In accordance with CAADS Bylaws, only Provider members may serve as elected Board members. The Board Development Committee seeks qualified nominees representing a variety of program types, geographic locations, and leadership skills with a commitment to advancing the mission of the organization. Directors are elected for a three-year term and may serve no more than two consecutive terms.

Qualifications for nomination to the CAADS Board of Directors:

- <u>Provider member in good standing</u> (dues fully paid or on an approved and up-to-date payment plan at the time of nomination).
- Able to attend all Board meetings, usually held monthly virtually or by toll-free teleconference;
 two CAADS Conferences one each spring in Northern California, and one each fall in
 Southern California; a Board Retreat in Sacramento; and pay for own travel and expenses.
- <u>Time to meaningfully contribute</u> to Board activities and serve on a minimum of two (2) committees.
- <u>Established record of attendance</u> at CAADS events such as conferences, education courses/training, membership meetings, or participation on CAADS committees, work groups, and teleconferences. **NOTE: No more than one person from any CAADS member group shall serve on the Board at any given time.**

Directors are elected for a three-year term and serve no more than two consecutive terms.

Qualifications for nomination to the A.L.E. Board of Directors:

- 1. <u>CAADS member in good standing</u> (dues fully paid or on an approved and up-to-date payment plan at the time of nomination).
- Must be able to attend four to six Board Meetings virtually or by toll-free teleconference, usually held in conjunction with CAADS Board meetings, and pay for own travel and expenses.
- 3. Time to contribute in a meaningful way to Board activities.
