
CBAS Emergency Remote Services (ERS)

PURPOSE: To allow for *immediate* response to address the continuity of care needs of CBAS participants when an emergency restricts or prevents them from receiving in-center services.



- Determined eligible for CBAS
- Approved IPC/TAR in place
- Signed Participation Agreement

START



TRIGGERING EVENT

Public Emergency

- 1) State/Local Disaster
 - -Earthquake
 - -Flood
 - -Fire
 - -Power Outage
- 2) Outbreak/Epidemic

Personal Emergency

- 1) Serious Illness/Injury
- 2) Crisis (sudden loss)
- 3) Transition

CBAS ERS INITIATION FORM (CEIF)

Timeframe

Submit to CDA and MCP:

- Within 3 working days
- Within 7 working days (if impact to ≥50% of participants)

If ERS
timeframe
crosses over a
new TAR
period, attach
original CEIF.

MEDICAL NECESSITY

The services and supports provided through ERS must be <u>time-limited</u> and necessary to:

- Protect life, address or prevent significant illness or disability, or alleviate severe pain
- Ensure continuity of care
- Address service gaps
- Promote return to the center!



ERS SERVICES

Continue to provide all services in IPC as appropriate and feasible. MDT must at least weekly document:

- Assessment of current medical and functional status
- Necessary adjustments made to IPC

Centers and MCPs must coordinate to ensure duration of ERS is appropriate during the current TAR period, and if necessary, reauthorization period.

END OF ERS EVENT

Return to Center

- Notify MCP when ERS ends and participant returns to center.
- Notify CDA and MCP within 24 hours of conclusion of any temporary pause.
- No "hybrid" services.

Discharge

- ERS no longer appropriate and alternative supports and services needed.
- OR consider possible reduction in the number of in-center days as medically indicated.



>90 DAYS

- Inform MCP at least 1 week prior to 90 days.
- Reassess participant for continued need for ERS.
 Centers and MCPs must coordinate on requests for authorization >90 days.
